

## **Sponsor a Chair**

As part of our SPRING building project, we are replacing the pews with chairs. These award-winning Trinity chairs give us greater flexibility as to how we use the space in church, and will allow us to run events and activities that were not possible with fixed pews.

We are raising funds in order to complete the next stage in our project and as part of this are offering the opportunity to sponsor a chair. Each sponsored chair can have a plaque in memory of a loved one or to denote an individual or community group.

You can sponsor a chair for a donation of £250 and a small plaque will be placed on the sponsored chair (please see conditions on reverse).

If you would like to make a donation of a smaller amount towards the cost of the chairs, this will be gratefully received. However, please note that smaller donations will not be eligible for a plaque.

## **Trinity Theo Chair**

The chairs we have chosen are designed specifically for churches and cathedrals, Theo is a lightweight, strong and durable wood framed, high density, stacking chair with a veneered plywood seat and back. There are a mix of upholstered and non-upholstered chairs, and some with arms.

The Theo chair has won numerous awards including the Church of England's Church Chair' competition and has been recognised by the Worshipful Company of Furniture Makers as an outstanding lightweight stackable chair.
